# 302 is not murder, 420 not cheating: Proposed Code

## Govt tables Bill to replace colonial-era laws; death for lynching and rape of minors

A Bill that Home Minister Amit Shah introduced in the Lok Sabha on Friday becomes the law of the land, Indian Penal Code (IPC) Section 302 would no longer prescribe the punishment for murder. It would instead relate to the crime of snatching in the proposed Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS). The BNS has no Section 420 of the IPC, which relates to the offence of cheating, and covers its Section 316.

On Friday, the concluding day of the monsoon session, Shah introduced three Bills in the Lok Sabha to replace colonial-era laws. He said it would overhaul the criminal justice system, end delays, and ensure justice in a maximum of three years. He introduced the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) Bill, 2023; Bharatiya Nagark Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) Bill, 2023; and Bharatiya Sakshya (BS) Bill, 2023 that will replace the Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860, Criminal Procedure Act (CrPC), 1898, and the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 respectively.

The Opposition criticised the new bills. The Congress said it was part of the bigger design of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to leave his imprint on everything and that for Modi, everything in the past, whether social, legal, cultural or political, was corrupt and needed overhauling. The ruling Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) in Tamil Nadu termed it "Hindi imposition" and an "audacious attempt" to tamper with India's diversity. In recent years, the other Bills with Hindi names are the Direct Tax Vivad Se Vishwas Bill of March 2020 and the Jan Vishwas Bill.

The BNS Bill provides maximum capital punishment for crimes such as mob lynching and rape of minors, the home minister said. The Bill also has provisions to provide community service as one of the punishments for first-time petty offences.

However, while it deletes Section 124 A of the IPC, which deals with sedition, the BNS has Section 152 that lists new offences such as acts of secession, armed rebellion, subversive activities, separatist activities or

endangering the sovereignty or unity and integrity of India. The section law, known as 'Rajdroh' has got a new term for it, 'Desdroh', thus doing away with the references to the British crown, officials said. Section 124 in the BNS relates to the crime of wrongful restraint.

In a post on X (previously Twitter), advocate Prashant Bhishan said: "Three hugely important laws which will affect all of us are introduced at the end of this session without any disclosure of discussion. The colonial wolf of sedition brought back in sheep's clothing."

Shah requested Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla to refer the three Bills for examination by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Home Affairs. Under the new laws, the charge sheet must be filed within 90 days and the court can give permission for another 90 days to look at the situation. The probe would have to be finished in 180 days and sent for trial. After trial, judgment will be given in 30 days.

Sexual exploitation of women on the pretext of marriage, job promotions, or by hiding identity will be considered a crime and attract up to 10-year imprisonment. The provision could cover cases of interfaith marriages under false names. For gang rape, there is a provision for punishment of 20 years imprisonment or life imprisonment, while there is a provision for a death sentence in case of rape with a minor. Community service is being introduced as a punishment for the first time.

Terrorism has been defined under the law for the first time, the minister said. There is also a provision for attaching the property of the terrorist. To stop political use of punishment waivers by governments, a new provision has been made that death sentences can only be converted to life imprisonment and life imprisonment be pardoned only within seven years of punishment.

Shah referred to the recent release of criminal-politician Anand Mohan in Bihar and said the provision had been made to ensure that those with political influence do not escape law.

## AAP MP RAGHAV CHADHA SUSPENDED FROM RS



Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MP Raghav Chadha was on Friday suspended from Rajya Sabha for "gross violation of rules, misconduct, defiant attitude, and contemptuous conduct", pending a report by the privileges committee. His suspension followed a motion moved by Leader of the House Piyush Goyal who sought action against the AAP leader for including names of some members of the Upper House without their consent in a proposed select panel for the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2023. Here's a list of MPs who were suspended from both the Houses in the monsoon session.

**Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury:** The Congress leader in the Lok Sabha was suspended on Thursday for allegedly attacking PM Narendra Modi during the no-trust debate.



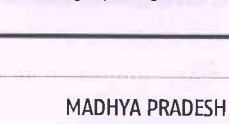
**Derek O'Brien:** TMC's Rajya Sabha member was suspended for his unruly behaviour. Chairman later said the motion was not put to vote and he could continue to attend the House.



**Sanjay Singh:** On July 24 suspended AAP's Rajya Sabha member Sanjay Singh for repeatedly "violating" the directives of the chair.

**Sushil Kumar Koiri:** On August 3, the AAP's Lok Sabha MP was suspended after he threw papers at the Chair after the Delhi Services Bill was passed.

**Rajni Patel:** Nearly 20 months after her suspension, the Congress Rajya Sabha MP was reinstated on August 7. She was suspended for allegedly video recording and publishing visuals.

# ₹6,000 crore set aside for land acquisition

Lucknow, 11 August

In a move to boost planned industrialisation and urbanisation, the Uttar Pradesh government has earmarked nearly 76,000 crore for land acquisition across the state.

The amount would be spent in purchasing land parcels from farmers and landowners in the arid Bundelkhand region. New townships in seven towns—Gorakhpur, Bareilly, Bulandshahr, Agra, Aligarh, Jhansi and Chitrakoot—will also be acquired.

While the major chunk of 55,000 crore would be spent on Bundelkhand land by the proposed Bundelkhand Industrial Development Authority (BIDA), the remaining portion of ₹21,000 crore would be incurred on new townships.

The acquisition is in addition to similar measures being taken by other industrial development authorities and the housing board in other districts, a senior official said. Meanwhile, UP industrial development minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi said that the government was toying the line of 'reform-perform-transform' to change the development landscape of the state.

"The state had netted more than 1,000 investment proposals worth ₹3.75 trillion for Bundelkhand region at the UP Global Investors Summit 2023 in February. To accelerate the development journey in the region, the BIDA blueprint has been drawn

up," he added. A recent UP cabinet meeting had cleared the proposal of injecting 88,000 crore in different industrial development authorities, of which the maximum 55,000 crore would be pumped in for BIDA alone.

An additional ₹1,000 crore has been allocated to the cities of Gorakhpur and Bareilly to receive the maximum ₹400 crore for land acquisition, followed by Agra and Aligarh at ₹150 crore each.

The Yogi government is planning to develop 100 new townships with the help of private investors to boost economic development and create jobs.

Earlier this year, the state claimed to have received proposals from almost 450 private investors for the ambitious new townships roadmap.

The new townships would be developed in the periphery of big cities to decongest urban centres and synergise development, economic activities, housing, and job market.

Besides, the state is in the process of rationalising building bylaws to facilitate higher vertical real estate growth.

At the same time, the private investment proposals in the pipeline entail acquisition of about 5,700 acres of land for setting up industrial units across 75 districts.

UP chief minister Yogi Adityanath has instructed UP industrial development authorities to ensure that land acquisition process was completed in a seamless manner.

# Women to handle toll booth ops

To empower women of the state, the Madhya Pradesh government has decided that women will now handle the operation of toll booths with a turnover of up to ₹2 crore annually. Chief Minister Shriwar Singh Chouhan reiterated this decision in a program organized in Anuppur district.

Recently, the Council of Ministers approved the policy for collection of consumer charges at toll booths by women self-help groups.

According to the decision, consumer fee collection will be done by women self-help groups on routes with annual collection income of less than ₹2 crore. Madhya Pradesh Road Development Corporation has been authorized to select such routes.

CM Chouhan has frequently said that women are one of the leading states in the field of planning and implementing schemes for women empowerment.

In other cities of the state, according to the tourism department, in 2022, over 100 million domestic tourists visited the state.

The tourism department is also creating new tourist circuits in the state.

The state has also seen a surge in religious tourism in recent years. In view of this, the state government will spend over ₹24 crore to give a fillip to religious tourism.
